This Agreement made and entered into this 18th day of June 1881 between Mr. C. H. Elligwick of the first part and J. T. Britt of the other part, witnesseth as follows: That whereas the said J. T. Britt is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain sufficient money for the amount of six thousand dollars (\$6,000) which among the several debts he has due to the said Mr. C. H. Elligwick, having on their part agreed to furnish such supplies to the said Britt as his part and in consideration of the above provisions doth hereby grant a lien to the said Mr. C. H. Elligwick an all the crops ^{which} may be raised during the year upon the lands of which the said Britt cultivates for the above amount of advances which has been or was intended to have been expended. Now it is further agreed by the parties to this agreement, that the said Mr. C. H. Elligwick shall be first paid and satisfied, after which the balance if any shall be paid over to the said J. T. Britt. This sum is granted under and act of the general assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1873 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes, containing the following signatures and seals
