This Deed made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of June in the year eighteen hundred and eighty one between Frank Wester and Rhoda H. Wester his wife of the first part and to Cooper Williams Trustee of the second part and H. Mos. Beaham & R. Frank Beaham committee of Jos. H. Beaham of the third part, all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part do hereby grant and convey unto the said Trustee, the following real estate to wit: all of that certain tract of land upon which the said parties of the first part now reside, which is situated in said County & is supposed to contain one hundred and forty and one third acres more or less including herein the seven acres lately assigned to him in the division of his father's real estate, and is bounded as follows: North by the Dick Milroy Swamp; East by the Mrs. Leachia Rouse as boggy tract; South by the lands of Mrs. Blythe & wife, and the James Adam and Blackwater Rock, and West by the lands of James Griffin's estate and of Asa White, the said seven acres was conveyed to the said Frank Wester by Deed from Matthew West, West's wife, Martha, James Black's wife, Emaline, John Blythe & wife, Lorina & others, recorded February 28<sup>th</sup> 1879. And the said parties of the first part do further grant and convey to the said Trustee a certain other lot or parcel of land supposed to contain five to ten acres more or less lying in said County, at an area Williams Cross Road and bounded by the lands of Elizabeth R. H. White, Asa White, James Griffin's heirs, and the land upon which Patsy Jenkins now resides, this land mentioned parcel of land being the same which were granted and conveyed by James Black to said Frank Wester by Deed of Bargain & Sale recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County, Court of said County, on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1879.
