1881 for 8 dollars Two dollars will interest the balance during
Crop of last year I am now above named Second to secure the
amount of One Hundred & fifteen dollars for account of my
supplier for this year It is agreed that if I as my representative
buys of C.W. Nicholson or his heirs the sum above mentioned or less
before the 1st of December & until such payment shall not excede
destroy sell or remove the same in case of death of the individual
myself responsible for the full value thereof receiving all Homestead
exemptions then there present & every thing herein contained shall
cure & void otherwise uncertain in force & effects An affidavit in the
foregoing condition C.W. Nicholson or his representative may
take the property at a fair cash valuation, or sell at auction for
ten days notice to me & advertising at his store retaining the sum
of money secured within & all cost of sale, including the surplus
from my heirs It is agreed also that until defacto all of these condi-
tions J. Anderson Edwards may retain possession of the property
provided I deliver my sole crop as further security for note to W.
Nicholson, Witness my hand & seal this 1st day of May in the year 1882

to secure a payment of Fifty or more dollars I in like due and bonds for
the year 1881 the same amount due and bonds for the year 1881 Second to secure
the amount of Forty dollars account abiding faithfully my supplier for this
last year Third to secure the sum of Sixty Five dollars & interest to be paid for
a black horse bought for me by C.W. Nicholson to whom he belongs until
paid for which I am obligated to pay at time this bill shall be due whether
