This Deed made this 27th day of June in the year one thousand eight
hundred & eighty one between R. A. Bristol of the aforesaid and
R. J. Williams Eccles of the other part Witnesseth that the said
R. A. Bristol doth grant unto the said R. J. Williams Trustee the
following property to wit: One certain Lot in the Village of Berlin
known as the J. C. Rocou Lot as described per Deed recorded in
Clerks Office of Southampton Co. In Trust to secure the payment of the
sum of \$1000 Noes hundred and fifty dollars, payable per bond
in hands of E. J. Gardner and a bill to him, in the event that if
not shall be made in the payment of the above mentioned bond then
the Trustee are either of them on being required so to do by E. J. Gardner
aforesaid their successors or assigns, shall sell the property hereby
concerned. And it is covenanted and agreed between the parties I
warrant that in case of a sale the same shall be made after first
advertising the time, place and time thereof for 10 days upon the
following terms to wit: For whatever sum of the procedure may
be necessary to defray the expenses of executing this trust, the fee for
the coin tenders recording this deed, if then required and to discharge
the amount of money then payable upon the said bond due to
E. J. Gardner and if there be any residue of said purchase money, the
same shall be made payable at such time and received in such
manner as the said R. A. Bristol executors administrators or
assigns shall prescribe and direct as in case of his failure to give
such direction aforesaid in such manner as the said Trustee
or either of them shall think fit, the said R. A. Bristol covenants to
pay all these assessments dues and charges upon the property hereby
concerned so long as he or his heirs or assigns shall hold the same.
