This Agreement made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June in the year 1881 between  
Nath'l. P. Ridley of Southampton County of the first part, and R. S. Pope  
of Southampton County of the second part, of the State of Virginia  
Witnesseth as follows: Wherein the said N. P. Ridley is engaged herein and  
about to engage in the cultivation of the soil. It is therefore that the  
said R. S. Pope shall during the present year make certain advances  
to the said cultivator of the soil which said R. S. Pope has agreed to  
do. Now this agreement witnesseth that the said R. S. Pope doth  
hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said  
N. P. Ridley during the present year such monies as provisions  
fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Eighty  
dollars in amount, for every bushel of mealable the said N. P.  
Ridley to cultivate and gather his Crop proportionate to be made  
the first year and the said N. P. Ridley hereby gives and grants  
to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all Crop that he may make on  
the lands which he has or may have in cultivation in the County  
of Southampton during the present year to wit Corn, Peeler  
Pear, Peanit, Cotton and all other Crop in order to secure the  
payment for all such supplies and advances as may be advanced  
above made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is  
made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia  
approved April 2, 1879. Witness our hands this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1881
