This Agreement made this 28th day of June in the year 1881 between Washington Artes of Southampton County, of the first part, and R S Pope of Southampton County of the second part, of the State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Washington Artes is engaged in an is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said R S Pope shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which said R S Pope has agreed to do. To which agreement witnesseth that the said R S Pope doth hereby promise to give and furnish to the said Washington Artes during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Fifty dollars in amount as may be needful to enable the said Washington Artes to cultivate and gather his crops as proposed to be made the present year. And the said Washington Artes hereby gives and grants to the said R S Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton during the present year to wit Corn, Peas, Pease, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops in actual receipt the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873. Witnesseth as aforesaid this 28th day of June 1881.
