This Agreement made this 23^d day of June in the year 1881 between Washington Bates of Southampton County, of the first part, and R. S. Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Washington Bates is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and it is desired that the said R. S. Pope shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil, which said R. S. Pope has agreed to do. Now this agreement Witnesseth that the said R. S. Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Washington Bates during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Forty dollars in amount, as may be necessary to enable the said Washington Bates to cultivate and gather his crops, proposed to be made the present year. And the said Washington Bates hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton during the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops in and to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 23^d day of June 1881.

Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Albert Barrett during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Fifty dollars in amount, as may be necessary to enable the said Albert Barrett to cultivate and gather his crops, proposed to be made the present year. And the said Albert Barrett hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which
