This Agreement made this 23rd day of June in the year 1881 between Tom Artis of Southampton County, one of the first parts of the State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows. That the said Tom Artis is engaged to R S Pope in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said R S Pope shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which said R S Pope has agreed to do. Where this Agreement so witnesseth. That the said R S Pope both hereby promises and agrees to due and furnish to the said Tom Artis during the present year such monies provisions, fuel, iron and other supplies not exceeding the sum of one hundred dollars in amount, as may be necessary to enable the said Tom Artis to cultivate and get his white crops produced to be made the present year. And the said Tom Artis hereby gives and grants to the said R S Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has, or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton during the present year to wit Corn, Peas, Raunch Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
