This Agreement made this 23^d day of June in the year 1881 between
Tom Artie of Southampton County ^{and as Rep. of Southampton for purpose of the second party} of the first part of this State of
Virginia Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Tom Artie is engaged
in or is about to engage in the cultivation of this soil, and is desirous
that the said R. S. Pope shall during the present year make certain
advances to the said cultivator of this soil, which said R. S. Pope has
agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesseth: That the said R. S. Pope
doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said
Tom Artie during the present year such money and provisions, fuel, &c.
as and at his self pleasure, not exceeding the sum of one hundred
dollars in amount, as may be needed to enable the said Tom Artie
to cultivate and gather his Crops for purposes to be made the present
year. And the said Tom Artie hereby gives and grants to the said
R. S. Pope a lien upon all Crops that he may make on the lands
which he has or may have in cultivation in the County of South-
ampton, during the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans,
Cotton and all other Crops in order to secure the payment for
all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not
