This wife of Southampton County, Virginia of the one part and
Henry S. Hill of said County of the other part, Witnesseth that the
parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Eight
Hundred and Fifty dollars do grant with general warranty
unto the said Henry S. Hill the following well settled to wit: the
one half acre lot known as the "Murren Lot" in said County, in
the village of Boykins Depot & on the East side of the County road
leading from Boykins Depot towards Murfreesboro, which
lot fronts on said road nearly five yards & running Eastward
parallel lines seven yards, all more enclosed, bounded west
