This Deed made and entered into this the 28<sup>th</sup> day of June A D 1881 between W<sup>m</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Beaton and Antoinette M<sup>r</sup> Beaton his wife Grantors of the first part and Henry L Hill grantee of the second part Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in Consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have this day granted bargained and sold and by these presents conveyed unto Henry L Hill the said party of the second part all that parcel or lot of Land at Boykins Depot Virginia lying on the County road running from Boykins to Murfreesboro N Carolina commencing at the lot now deeded by Alexander Knight and running along the County road South to the line thereof and continued by due to John Muller from George W Hoble and from the said Knights lot east about eighty five yards thence South to the Muller lot about one hundred and fifty yards thence along the line of the Muller lot East to the said County road containing two acres or the same more or less. It being the lot known as the Parker Reel lot. The said H L Hill agrees that there shall not be a barroom or ancient spirit sold on place to have and to hold the said lot unto the said Henry L Hill his heirs & forever and the said parties of the first part do covenant with the said H L Hill that they will defend the right and title to the said lot against the lawful claims of any and all persons whom soever.
