This Agreement entered into this 11th day of May 1881 between Mrs M Beaton trading under the firm name of Mrs M Beaton & Co of one part and R L Byrant of the other part, Witnesseth: That whereas the said R L Byrant is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain during the year 1881 advances in supplies from the said Mrs M Beaton & Co to the amount of Two hundred & fifty dollars beyond which limit the said Byrant shall not go and the said Mrs M Beaton & Co having agreed to furnish the said advances more the said R L Byrant on his part in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a lien to the said Mrs M Beaton & Co on the crops of all kinds which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or soon intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 3rd 1873 entitled An Act to secure advances for agricultural purposes, Witness the following signatures,
