This Agreement made this 20th day of May in the year 1881 between
 W^c A. Applewhite & Mollie P. Gurley of the first part, and Bertram
 Sumner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton State of
 Virginia, Witness as follows: Whereas the said W^c A. Applewhite &
 Mollie Gurley is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the
 soil, and is desirous that the said Bertram Sumner should during the
 present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil
 which the said Bertram Sumner has agreed to do, Now this Agreement
 Witnesseth, That the said Bertram Sumner do hereby promise and
 agree to advance and furnish to the said Applewhite & Gurley during
 the present year such money, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies
 not exceeding the sum fifty dollars in amount as may
 be needed to enable the said Applewhite & Gurley to cultivate and
 gather his crops, provided to be made the present year, And the
 said Applewhite & Gurley hereby give and grants to the said Bertram
 Sumner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year
 to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Pumpkins, Cotton and all other crops in
 order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as
 may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This
 Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly
 of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873, Witness our hands this 20th day
 of May 1881.

Whereas Jno. P. Peltors Jr & Eva B. his wife, Saml B. Peltors & M. W. his
 wife, J. P. Peltors & M. J. his wife, did sell to James H. Platt on
 the 25th day of April 1872 a certain piece or parcel of land lying near
 Franklin's Point in Southampton County & described as follows: Beginning
 at a Post 30 feet from S. R. Road said piece a corner for James H. Platt
 and thence along said Edwards line S 74° 48' 48" E Chain 100
 10 6 32 Chain to the post, thence N 72° 40' 10" E Chain to Rock Road
 thence along said road to the post at the beginning containing 5 1/2 1/10
 acres more or less, and the said James H. Platt did by a letter written
 to Jno. Peltors April 13th 1877 direct the said Peltors to execute a Deed
 for said land to Joseph Gregory, which letter is here with filed and
 wherein the said Joseph Gregory by his written statement here with
 filed has directed the said Peltors to execute a Deed for said land
 to Jackson Barnett. Now this Deed made this 2nd day of January 1881
