This Agreement entered into this 24th day of June 1881 between Geo W. Turner and J. E. P. Turner, merchants and factors, trading under the firm name of Turner & Bros, of one part, and John N. Person of the other part, Witnesseth, That whereas the said John N. Person is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain during the year 1881 advances in money to sufficient from the said Turner & Bros the amount of Two hundred Dollars, beyond which limit the said John N. Person shall not go, and the said Turner & Bros being agreed on this part to furnish the said advances, now the said John N. Person on his part, in consideration of the above premises doth hereby grant alien to the said Turner & Bros an act of credit which may be made during the year 1881 upon the land in the cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to be or been expended, this being all granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873 entitled "An Act to secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes".
