This Deed made this the 13th day of February 1880 between Fanny Joyner & Matthew Williams & Eliza his wife of the first part & P. Woodson Scott of the second part, with full and Consideration of Penalties, paid to them by the said P. Woodson Scott, the said Fanny Joyner & Matthew Williams & Eliza his wife do hereby grant unto the said P. Woodson Scott all the land within the boundaries as follows: The line commencing at a Pine tree near the catch maple stump in Broons road running south west to a post then to a post southeast on Wiley Joyner's children's line, thence along North east to a corner between P. Woodson Scott's line then up the Branch to the beginning containing three acres more or less. Witness the following signatures & seals:

This Agreement made this 1st day of June in the year 1881 between William Whitfield of the first part and Robt B Smith of the other part both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia Witness us as follows: Whereas the said William Whitfield is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Robt B Smith shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil, which the said Robt B Smith has agreed to do. Now this agreement witnessed: That the said Robert B Smith does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said William Whitfield during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not to exceed the sum of Two hundred and Seventy five dollars in amount) as may be needed to enable the said William Whitfield to cultivate and gather his crops, proposal to be made the present year. And the said William Whitfield hereby gives and grants to the said Robt B Smith a lien upon all such crops as may make the present year to wit: corn, Paddy, Rice, Peanuts, cotton
