This Deed made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of Augt 1879 between R W Pittman of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the first part and los Holland of the County of Isle of Wight of the other part. Witnesseth That the party of the first part doth grant and sell and confirm unto the party of the second part a certain Seuer of mill with its appurtenances and fixtures thereto belonging nowe located in the County of Southampton and in the said mill is situated by me of A H Ashburn In Trust to secure the payment of a certain negotiable note executed by the said R W Pittman and endorsed by Jno Lumpkin & M L Watkins the bearing date Aug 23<sup>rd</sup> 1879 and payable Sixty days after date at the人民 Bank of Newbern and as any note the Party be given in payment of the same should the said R W Pittman pay the said note at maturity so that no difficult is made then this writing is to all intents and purposes null & void but in the event of failure to do so and default is made and the said A H Ashburn shall exectute the said los Holland chosen Trustee shall after giving lawful notice at sundry public places convenient to sell the said Mill and its appurtenances and fixtures thereto belonging at public auction for cash and after first deducting lawful expenses pay off the said note with the interest that may have accrued in full of the amount left in hand be sufficient and if there should be surplus left in hand pay the same over to the said R W Pittman. Witnesseth the following signature and seal the day month & year first above written.

That I do in behalf of the County of Southampton Virginia in consideration of the sum of one Hundred & Thirty Dollars to be paid by Dr G C Nicholson in sufficient merchandise to be shown by due bills and accounts for the same to sell and convey unto him the following property to wit: on my entire crop of cotton & Peanuts & flocks made in 1881 to have and hold to him the greater and his heirs or assigns forever. I covenant this property free of all incumbrances and fully defend the same. It is agreed however that if the grantor does not representatively pay unto Dr G C Nicholson or his representatives the sum above mentioned before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Dec 1881 in redemption for this property and until such payment shall not exceed six months, injure sell or remove the same and in case of injury or death from any cause of any cattle horses as he or they conveyed hold myself his and a signed witness for the full value thereof retaining all monies due or to become due for the same and every thing held in contains shall curse and be
