

In the County Court of Southampton County,
 Pursuant to an order of the said Court made at the May term 1881 a
 copy of which is herewith filed, appointing Commissioners to assign to
 Mrs John H. Saunders widow of John H. Saunders deceased the Homestead
 as personal property to which she is entitled to have and to hold out of
 the estate of the said John H. Saunders died, the husband, who was a house-
 holder and head of a family in said County and died without having
 selected as her own and upon it the Homestead as personal property to which
 he was entitled under the Constitution and laws of Virginia, the under-
 signed three of the Commissioners thus appointed as perfectly proper
 that confirm no real estate belonging to the said John H. Saunders but
 that we do find a small personal estate I or your Commissioners thus
 appointed as and for the personal property to which the aforesaid widow
 is entitled under the statute do hereby declare that is here assigned to her
 the following property to wit: one negotiable note for twenty seven dollars
 made and executed by Josiah Tenson and endorsed by R. P. Bell dated
 on the 4th day of June 1881, one negotiable note for ten dollars dollar
 made and executed by Lewis Saddle and dated on the 15th day of May and
 endorsed by John R. Ruck and John Davis payable 90 days after date
 at the Bank of Windsor, one note for fourteen dollars and thirty cen-
 ts made and executed by R. P. Bell and dated on the 7th day of June
 1881 and also all the household & Kitchen furniture not included in the
 Poor debtors has all the stock of goods remaining unsold belonging to John
 H. Saunders valued at two hundred and fifty dollars the aforesaid
 Household and Kitchen furniture is valued at one hundred and fifty
 dollars and several other accounts as shown by books amounting in
 all to one hundred and one dollar and also seventy fourth 7/10 dollars
 deposited in the Bank of Windsor to the credit of Mrs John H. Saunders
 widow of John H. Saunders died, given under our hands this 29th
 day of June 1881

At a Court held for the County of Southampton day of August 1881
 before the application of Mrs John H. Saunders for a Homestead
 to be assigned her and her minor children out of the estate of her deceased
 husband John H. Saunders. This day came the applicant by her attorney
 and the report of the Commissioners assigning a Homestead to the applicant
 and her minor children having been returned and continued for exception
 for one month and more and the exceptions being filed thereto was this
 day examined and confirmed by the Court and declared to be recorded
 and it is ordered that the applicant and her minor children have
 and enjoy the Homestead & property assigned them according to law and
 that they pay the costs of these proceedings
