This Agreement made this 17th day of Aug in the year 1881 between
General Garrison Lenoir of Southampton County, of the first part and R. S. Pope
of Southampton County, of the second party the State of Virginia witnesseth as follows: That the said Garrison Lenoir is engaged in the
cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said R. S. Pope shall
during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator
of the soil which said R. S. Pope has agreed to do, now this agreement
witnesseth: That the said R. S. Pope doth hereby promise and agree to
advance and furnish to the said Garrison Lenoir during the present
year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not
exceeding the sum of Two hundred dollars in amount as may be
necessary to enable the said Garrison Lenoir to cultivate and gather
his crop proposed to be made the present year. And the said Garrison
Lenoir hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all
crop that he may make on the lands which he has, or may hereafter
cultivate in the County of Southampton during the present year
to secure the payment for such supplies and advances as may be
