This Agreement made this 17th day of Aug in the year 1881 between Garrison Lenoir of Southampton County, of the first part and R. S. Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, by the State of Virginia, witness as follows: Whereas the said Garrison Lenoir is engaged in the cultivation of the soil, and it is desired that the said R. S. Pope shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil, which said R. S. Pope has agreed to do, now this agreement witnesseth that the said R. S. Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Garrison Lenoir during the present year such money, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Two hundred dollars in amount as may be needed to enable the said Garrison Lenoir to cultivate and gather his crops, provided to be made the present year. And the said Garrison Lenoir hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has, as may hereinafter be used in the County of Southampton during the present year to soil, Corn, Sorghum, Rice, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for such supplies and advances as may be
