This Agreement made this 20th day of August in the year 1881, between Wm. H. Pond of Southampton County, of the first part, and R. S. Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia, contents as follows: Whereas the said Wm. H. Pond is engaged in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said R. S. Pope should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which said R. S. Pope has agreed to do, Now this agreement witnesses that R. S. Pope doth hereby ^{fully} and agree to advance and furnish to the said Wm. H. Pond during the present year such monies for provisions, fertilizer and other supplies not exceeding the sum of One Thousand Dollars in amount, as may be needed to enable the said Wm. H. Pond to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year, and the said Wm. H. Pond hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton during the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not excluding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873, without our hands this 20th day of August 1881.
