This Oath of Trust made this 19th day of August 1881 between Jessie C. Moore and
James W. Moore her husband of the County of Southampton State of Virginia
of the first part Grantor and J. D. Pitts of the same County of the second part
Known as trustee with the following in order to secure the payment of a certain
debt to be hereinafter described they the said Jessie C. Moore and James W. Moore
degrant and convey with general warranty unto the said J. D. Pitts trustee
the following real property to wit: That of a certain parcel or lot of land lying and
situated in the County of Franklin County of Virginia bought by the said grantors from
John Morris wife by Deed dated April 18th 1881 described and bounded as follows: Com-
mencing on the west side of Main Street at the north west corner of the lot on which J. A.
Butcher's store house formerly stood and running thence along said street in
a northerly direction 23 feet 4¹/₂ inches thence in an easterly direction to and
along a sloping wall 70 feet thence in same direction along middle of said
lot conveyed by Morris to Mrs. W. H. Butler lying this line from main street
to Mrs. Butler's lot being 310 feet thence forward along Mrs. Butler's line
and also J. M. Morris's line 23 feet 4¹/₂ inches to said Butcher's lot thence in an
easterly direction along said Butcher's line 310 feet to main street the point
of beginning containing a little less than 1/4 acre in trust to secure the payment
of such debt referred to above to wit: One Bond bearing date the 19th day of August
1881 and due with interest payable semi annually from date as demand by the

for a period of thirty days at the expiration of which time he shall sell said
lot for cash and if by the proceeds of sale as the law directs And the said
grantor further covenant to insure any improvements erected on said lot
in some good responsible Insurance Company for the sum of at least one
thousand dollars for the benefit of Mary H. Pitts so long thereafter following
