This Indenture made this the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 1881 between R. P. Elliott  
Rebecca J. Elliott his wife, of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the  
first part and and Charles Cook also of said County and State of the  
second part witnesseth that the said party of the first part in consideration  
of the sum of Fifty Seven Dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged to have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant  
languish and sell unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns  
a certain lot of land at or near Branchville Va in the County of Southampton  
containing two thirds 2/3 of an acre more or less and bounded as follows:  
commencing at a marked white oak in about 50 yds North West of the  
house of G. E. Harrison Est running South East about 20 or 25 yds to a post  
thence West along by the side of the land or lot of said Harrison Est to a cliff  
from adjoining the land of said Holland Est thence North along by the  
Holland Est land 20 or 25 yds to a small crooked white oak, thence about  
along by the land of said Elliott to the white oak the place of commencement  
And so the party of the first part do covenant with the said party of the  
second part that they shall quietly enjoy and use all the aforesaid  
premises that they can have from all encumbrances and that no person except  
right to sell and convey the same, and that no will or warranty deed
