This Agreement made this 18th day of March 1881 between George E. Beaton of the one part and Jephtha Lewis both of Southampton County of the other part, witnesseth that whereas Jephtha Lewis is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain advances of money from the said George E. Beaton to the amount of eighty dollars, beyond which he limit the said Jephtha Lewis shall not go, and the said George E. Beaton having agreed to furnish said amount of advances now to the said Jephtha Lewis on his part and in consideration of the above furnished herby grant a lien to the said George E. Beaton on all the crop or produce during the year 1881 upon the land in cultivation of which the above amount of advances was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 1st 1873 Entitile and to secure advances for Agricultural Purposes, witness the following signatures.
