This Agreement made and entered into this the 16th day of March 1881 by George E. Beaton, merchant and doing business at Blandsville Virginia and Hyram Clements, witnesseth that whereas the said Hyram Clements is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain advances in sufficient sum from the said George E. Beaton, during the year 1881 to the amount of eighty dollars beyond which limit the said Hyram Clements shall not go, and the said George E. Beaton having an his part agreed to furnish said amount of advances, now the said Hyram Clements on his part, and in consideration of the above premises doth hereby grant a lien to the said George E. Beaton on all the crops made during the year 1881 upon the lands in cultivation of which the said amount of advances were intended to have been expended. This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2^d 1873 Entitled an Act to secure creditors for Agricultural Purposes, witness the following signatures,
