This Indenture made the second day of oct. in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty six between Nathan Williford of Southampton county of the one part & Thomas Putton of the same county of the other parts witnesseth that this Nathan Williford for & in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds money of Virginia by him in hand paid by the said Thomas Putton the receipt of which money is hereby acknowledged by the said Nathan Williford hath granted bargained & sold aliened enfeofed confirmed by then presents with grant bargain & sell alien confirmed unto the said Thomas Putton his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being on the north side of Copsebrook Swamp in the aforesaid county being part of a patent granted to Benjamin Pitman bearing date the 30 day of march 1713 & given thus Williford by his father In^r Williford (beginning) at a lightwood stake in Wincoak percheson in a line of Benjamin Pitmans thence along a dividing line between John Willifords & Benjamin Pitmans to a firm a corner tree of theajah Edwards land thence eastward along Edwards line about half a mile or more to a oak at the head of a branch called the Butte branch thence along a straight line of marked trees made by the said Nathan Williford & Thomas Putton to the first station containing seventy five acres more or less with all the estate right title interest property claim & demands whatsoever of him the said Nathan Williford of in or to the same or any part or parcel thereof To have & to hold this said seventy five acres of land above mentioned every part & parcel thereof unto the said Thomas Putton his heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Thomas Putton his heirs & assigns forever of the said Nathan Williford for him & his heirs the said seventy five acres of land every part & parcel thereof against himself & his heirs & agst all & every other person or persons whatsoever unto the said Tho^s Putton his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend by then presents In witness whereof the said Nathan Williford hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & year above written
