This Indenture made this 11th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and sixty seven between John Taylor of Southampton county of the one part
of Thos. Turner of the county afores. of the other part witnesseth that Thos. Taylor of the
one part for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds sterling money of Virginia in
hand paid to the S. Taylor by Thomas Turner before the making of delivery of the
premises the receipt whereof the S. Taylor doth hereby acknowledge have each of
them hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeofed confirmed of by their presents do
each of them doth grant bargain sell alien enfeof confirm unto the S. Thomas
Turner of his heirs assigns for ever one tract or parcel of land containing
one hundred acres more or less lying being in the county of Southampton and
bounded as followeth. beginning at a pine in Tarverns creek thence along a
line of run marked trees to a pine a corner thence along a line of run marked
trees to a poplar in Arsons branch thence up the various courses of the stream
to a hickory in Arthur Taylors line thence along his line to a pine a corner from
thence along the afores. line to the beginning this land being part of a patent
granted to Thomas Taylor bearing date the thirtieth day of March seven hundred
and forty three since become vested in the S. Taylor party to the pre-
sents with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens woods ways water
water courses profits commodities hereditaments appurtenances to the S. tract or
