This Indenture made the eleventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty seven Between Joseph Gray of the county of Southampton of the one part & Edwin Gray son of the said Joseph Gray of the other part witnesseth that the said Joseph Gray for and in consideration of the natural love and affection for his son Edwin Gray hath given granted and confirmed by these presents doth give and bargain and sell unto the said Edwin Gray one certain tract or parcel of land containing eight hundred acres situate lying being in the county of Southampton of a part of a circular tract of land of six miles diameter which by an act of assembly made in the eighth year of our now reigning Lord George the second incorporated the Notaway Indians of their trustees hath the said circular tract of land from the said Joseph Gray purchased four hundred acres by deed of bargain and sale bearing date the twenty fourth day of March one thousand seven hundred and sixty seven recorded in the court of Chancery the other four hundred acres purchased of Wm Bailey by deed of bargain and sale bearing date the twenty ninth day of October one thousand seven hundred and sixty four recorded in the court of Southampton of recorded and the said deeds are expressly referred unto by the said indenture and will more fully appear with the insertion of the remainder of the said indenture with and annex of the said premises every part thereof shall all the estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of him the said Joseph Gray or of the said premises every part thereof To have and to hold all singular the said premises within mentioned every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Edwin Gray his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Edwin Gray his heirs and assigns forever of the said Joseph Gray for himself his heirs the said land of premises every part thereof against him or his his heirs and assigns all every other person or persons whatsoever shall or will warrant or for ever defend unto the said Edwin Gray his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof the said Joseph Gray hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written
