This Indenture made the twentieth day of July in the sixth year of the reign
our sovereign lord George the third king of Great Britain of in the year of our lord
one thousand seven hundred & sixty seven Between W^m Bryant of the city of Hamp-
ton of Virginia of the one part & Lewis Jeyner of the county of York of
the other part witnesseth that the S. W^m Bryant for & in consideration of the
sum of fifteen hundred & twenty money of Virginia to him in hand paid by
Lewis Jeyner & or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof the S. W^m Bryant doth hereby acknowledge & hereof acquit & dis-
charge the S. Lewis Jeyner his executors & assigns & by these presents hath gran-
ted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released & confirmed & by these presents
doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release & confirm unto the S. Lewis
Jeyner & his heirs & assigns forever all that plantation tract or parcel of
land situate lying & being in the parish of Nottoway & county of Southampton
& bounded as followeth To wit. beginning at a pine on the south side of the Indian
an field branch a corner tree between Joseph Denong & Thomas Drake thence by
the S. Drakes line crossing the S. branch north sixty two degrees east twenty five
poles to a pine thence north seventy degrees east to a black oak thence a straight
course across the dividend of land to a spanish oak thence south west one hundred
& fifty four poles to a pine by the side of the Indian field branch aforesaid
thence up the run of the S. branch to the beginning including one hundred
