By the said Will of the said John Knorr of Kent, his wife Abigail Knorr by a deed bearing date the 3rd day of July 1756 by the said John Knorr was given devised to his daughter Abigail Knorr by his last will & testament in manner aforesaid of the decan of the said Abigail Knorr if it should so come the property of the said Knorr aforesaid as far as law as by the said Will of the said Knorr will appear of all houses outhouses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards woods trees ways waters water courses profits commodities hereditaments appurtenances to the said plantation tract or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining of the reversions & reversions thereunto & remainders & remainders & profits thereof of all the estate right title interest claim & demand whatsoever of them the said John Knorr of Kent by his wife & in or to the same or any part thereof of all deeds evidences writings touching or any wise or concerning the same To have & to hold the said plantation tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging & appertaining unto the said John Knorr his heirs & assigns to the only use & behoof of the said John Knorr his heirs & assigns forever of the said John Knorr of Kent by his wife for themselves their heirs & assigns do covenant promise & agree to give to the said John Knorr his heirs & assigns by the presents that the said John Knorr of Kent his wife shall & will from time to time at all times for ever hereafter make do execute or cause to be made done or executed such further & other ~~and other~~ acts & deeds things & things devices conveyances & assurances in the law for the further or better conveying & securing the premises aforesaid unto the said John Knorr his heirs & assigns as by the said John Knorr his heirs & assigns or his or their counsel learned in the law shall be reasonably devised or required & also that they the said John Knorr of Kent his wife the said plantation tract or parcel of land & premises with the appurtenances will warrant & forever defend the said John Knorr his heirs & assigns against them the said John Knorr of Kent his wife their heirs & assigns addition or appurtenances all giving other person or persons whatsoever claiming or to claim the same by from or under him them or any of them In witness whereof the said John Knorr of Kent his wife hath hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day & year first above written
