hundred & sixty seven between Ephraim Williams of Shamrock his wife of Shamrock city for
himself & Jerm Williams of the 3rd county of the other part witnesseth that the
Ephraim Williams for consideration of the sum of five hundred & twenty five pounds
Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Jerm Williams the receipt whereof the said Epa-
phraim Williams doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed
confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey confirm
firm unto the said Jerm Williams his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or
parcel of land lying & being in the county aforesaid containing by estimation
two hundred acres situate between the
beginning at a white oak a corner between of Wm Jerm of Ephraim Williams running
by the said Williams line south sixty nine degrees west one hundred & eighty six poles to a
line then by the said Davis line north thirty degrees west eighty six poles to a
quad pole between the said Davis & Wm Vick then by the said Vick line north
twenty five degrees east one hundred & eighty six poles to a pine tree corner then by the
same north eighty degrees east one hundred & eighty six poles to a pine tree corner of the
said Vick then east eighty eight poles to a pine tree then south seventy eight degrees east
eighty four poles to a Hickory in Wm Jerm then by the said Jerm line south thirty
four degrees west seventy two poles to a pine tree south two degrees west seventy two poles to
