George the third by the grace of God of Great Britain France of Ireland King Defender of the Faith
And in the year of our lord God one thousand seven hundred. given under the Great Seal of Great Britain
in the parish of St. Botolph of county of Southampton of the north part of Rich^d. Henry of the parish of
county of the other part with the said the said Sir Henry for the consideration of the sum of
pounds eight hundred of Leg. to him in hand paid by the said Rich^d. Henry also by the
conceding and allowing of the presents the receipt whereof the said Sir Henry doth hereby acknowledge
the said Sir Henry doth hereby certify that he is fully satisfied and contented of the said Sir Henry from and
whom he hath received the said sum of pounds eight hundred for the said Sir Henry's and his heirs and assigns
forever all and singular the said Sir Henry's and his heirs and assigns shall and lawfully shall and lawfully shall

woods under roads cornered at the advantage hereditaments ways waters gaps with
whatsoever to the said land above mentioned belonging or in anywise appertaining
And also the reversion of the said remainder of the said rents issues profits of the said
premises of every part and parcel thereof of all the estate right title interest claim
demand whatsoever of him the said Sir Henry his heirs and assigns of every part thereof
