 Between Mr. Arrington J. of the City of Virginia & Province of Carolina of the one part &
 Peter Butts of the county of Southampton in Virg of the other part witnesseth that the said
 Arrington J. for & in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current money of Virginia
 to him in hand paid at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt of where
 & himself fully satisfied contented & paid doth hereby acknowledge hath granted
 bargained sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant bargain
 alien & confirm unto the said Peter Butts his heirs & assigns forever one certain plan-
 tation & tract of land lying & being in the aforesaid county of Southampton & being
 the land & plantation whereon Mr. Adams now lives containing one hundred
 eighty acres of land to the same more or less & bounded as followeth to wit beginning
 at the mouth of a small branch running between the said plantation & the old planta-
 tion then running up the said branch to the fork then E. to Mr. Chappels line then
 along the said Chappels line to a pine a corner of the said Chappels land then along
 the said Chappels land to a gum in Crookers swamp then up the said swamp to the be-
 ginning also all woods underwoods ways water & water courses & with all profits
 commodities & advantage to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining to
 the remainder & remainder with & service of the said premises & every part thereof
 & also all the estate right title interest claim & demand whatsoever of him the
 Arthur Arrington J. of & to the same premises & every part thereof of John
 & to hold all & singular the said premises above mentioned & every part thereof
