David Johnson personally appeared in court & being first sworn examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the S. indenture.

This indenture made this twenty seventh day of Janry. in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight between Mr. Brecon & Ann his wife of the county of Southampton of the one part & Wm Kemp of the S. county of the other part witnesseth that the S. John Brecon & Ann his wife for & in consideration of the sum of £100 pounds of good money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the S. Wm Kemp at & before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the S. John Brecon & Ann his wife doth hereby acknowledge both granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the S. Wm Kemp his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land (it being part of seven hundred & forty acres granted by patent bearing date the 10 day of July 1750 to Henry Rose lying & being in the county aforesaid on the South side of the Weymouth river & bounded as followeth to wit on the east side by a line of marked trees &c. between the land of John & Richard on the south side by Dr. Turner land on the west & north side by two short lines of marked trees & a branch called one of the old branches which divide the S. land from Ann Harris land (the S. land of the Thomas being likewise part of the patent & the S. two short lines & the branch aforesaid divide the S. Ann Harris land from the S. land was marked & run by the judgment of Joshua Land & Dr. Thos with the consent of Henry Thos & Wm Johnson the S. land was conveyed from the S. Henry Thos to the S. Wm Johnson & from the S. Wm Johnson to Joseph Mathews & from the S. Mathews to the S. John Brecon & has been & has been held & possessed & managed to be ever since the dividing line between one hundred & fifty acres be the same.
