Know all men by these presents that I the Day of the county of Southampton  
of the parish of St. Luke for diverse good causes & valuable consideration had from especially for  
the consideration of the good will & affection I bear to my two living daughters Sarah & Mary  
I do give grant & demise unto each of them the negroes & man  
hereafter mentioned to each respectively to be taken into their possession & enjoyment  
after my decease in whole hands as persons sover they be found at that time To wit  
I give & demise unto my daughter Sarah a slave a slave as a slave & to wit  
namely Ben & Mary to live & serve for ever & likewise to my daughter Mary & to  
her forever after my decease I give two negroes namely Tarry & Joe & do hereby  
warrant & for ever defend them from any person or persons whatsoever that shall  
lay any claim or title thereto And I give unto my daughter Sarah twelve  
pounds current money & provided my daughter Sarah or Mary each or either  
of them should die without issue of their own body that then the estate of the same  
said money given shall be equally between the other surviving sister of the other  
of their following sisters namely Rebecca Priscilla & Elizabeth Brown Day  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 8 day  
March 1760

This indenture

made this ninth day of Feb. in the year of our lord one  
thousand seven hundred & eighty eight between Jm. Windham of the county of Hampton  
of the one part & Britain Travers of the same county of the other part witnesseth that  
this Jm. Windham for & in consideration of the love & good will which he hath for  
himself the said Britain Travers hath given granted & sold aloned & conveyed unto  
himself & by these presents do give grant & sell unto himself & convey unto  
the said Britain Travers his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract of land  
containing one hundred acres of land more or less lying & being in the county  
of Southampton being part of a parcel granted to this Jm. Windham for three  
hundred & thirty six acres bearing date the sixteenth day of August one thousand  
seven hundred & eighty six & bounded as followeth beginning at a pine acre in the  
of Woods Wood land thence along a line of marked trees made by this Jm.  
ham to the head of the long branch thence down the branch to Main Point  
line including all that part of this Jm. Windham land lying above the said  
line mentioned in the patent & the river on & down the river
