same county & parish of the other part witnesseth that the S. Joseph Cobb
& Catharine his wife for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & thirty pounds
certain money of Virg. to them in hand paid by the S. Thomas Crenshaw the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged have granted bargain sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents
perfectly & absolutely grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the S. Tho. Cren-
shaw his heirs or certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the parish of
St. Luke county of Southampton containing by estimation three hundred & fifty acres
& bounded as follows to wit. beginning at a pine on the south side the Meadow
swamp just below the mouth of a small branch then running near a stream
up the S. branch one hundred & twenty pole to a pine then near an E. course on a line
of marked trees to a red oak a made corner standing in the afore^d Joseph Cobb line then
on the Cobb line south five degrees east to a pine the afore^d Cobb corner then
near an east course to the head of a small branch then down the various
