This Indenture made the twentieth day of February in the year of our Lord God on this
said seven hundred & sixty eight between Willm Joynes of the parish of Stottery in the county
of Southampton planter of the one part & Dempsey Denson of Halifax county in N Carolina of the
other part witnesseth that the said Dempsey Denson for and in consideration of the sum of six
hundred pounds current money of King to the said Dempsey Denson in hand paid by the said Joynes
the receipt whereof the said Dempsey Denson both hereby acknowledge & therupon
discharge the said Willm Joynes hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed by the
present both grand bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the said William Joynes his
heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the above
parish of Stottery County of Southampton on the north side of Black Creek containing
by estimation one hundred acres to the same more or less bounded as followeth to wit beginning
at a corner of John Moul's land & running along his line to a corner of the said Moul's
land thence along the line that divides his land from the above mentioned land to a cor-
ner of Richd Moul's land thence along his land to Black Creek thence up the various
course of the run of the creek to the beginning the said land being willed to the said Dempsey
Denson by his grandfather John Denson and all houses and houses edifices buildings
yard gardens ways waters watercourses profits commodities hereditaments & appur-
tenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or any way appertaining to
the reversion and reversions remainder & remainders rents issues & profits thereof and all the
estate right title interest property claim demand & redress of him the said Dempsey
Denson of in and to the same & every part thereof and all deeds evidences & writings touching
or any wise concerning the same To have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land & premises
with the appurtenances unto him the said William Joynes his heirs & assigns forever of the said Dempsey
Denson for himself his heirs & assigns & administrators both covenants & promising
to give with the said William Joynes his heirs & assigns that the said Dempsey Denson and
his heirs the said tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances
unto the said William Joynes his heirs & assigns against all title claim & demand
