 said county of the other part witnesseth that the said William Hallaman for & in consideration of the
 sum of ten pounds current money to him in hand paid by the said Nathan Hallaman the receipt
 whereof the said William Hallaman doth hereby acknowledge he the said William Hallaman hath granted
 bargained sold aliened and confirmed & by these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened & confirmed
 confirm unto the said Nathan Hallaman his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of
 land containing one hundred and thirty acres lying & being in the county of Southampton
 the South side the main Black Water swamp & bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine
 on his own line thence along his own line to a black oak thence by a straight line to a pine
 thence along a line to a pine thence along William Hallamons line to a maple thence to the beginning
 being a certain tract or parcel of land formerly granted by patent to William Hallamons
