This Indenture tripartite made this tenth day of November in the seventh year of  
the reign of our sovereign lord King George the third & in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand  
seven hundred & sixty seven between William Bonner of the parish of in the county  
of Prince George of the first part Sylvia Tyus of the parish of Totteray & County of Southam  
videtur relidit & executio &c. of Abraham Tyus late of the county of Sussex deceased of the second part  
& William Williamson of the said parish of Totteray & County of Southampton of the third part  
Whereas there is a marriage by good grace intended to be solemnized between the said William  
& Bonner & the th<sup>d</sup>. Sylvia Tyus & it is agreed between the said William Bonner & Sylvia Tyus  
that the th<sup>d</sup>. William Bonner shall only have & receive with the said Sylvia Tyus the sum  
of twenty shillings & two pence money of Virginia for her marriage portion & that the said  
Sylvia Tyus is to dispose of all the residue of her estate real & personal which she now has  
in possession or may have right to claim either in her own right or as executrix of the  
last will & testament of the said Abraham Tyus deceased to such person or persons for such use  
and purpose as she shall think fit as to her the said Sylvia Tyus shall seem fitting Now this  
Indenture witnesseth that in pursuance of the said agreement & for consideration of the sum of  
five shillings to her the said Sylvia Tyus in hand paid at & before the sealing & delivery of  
this present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged for divers other good causes & considerations  
her the said Sylvia Tyus thenceforth moving she the said Sylvia Tyus hath by & with the free  
knowledge consent & agreement of him the said William Bonner testified by his being made a  
party to & signing sealing of this present granted bargain & sold & assigned & made over to the said  
William Williamson both grand bargain & sell & assign made over unto the said William Williamson of the  
him and assign. All such lands & slaves & stock of cattle houses & outhouses together with all  
judgments mortgages bonds bills notes & specialties which she the said Sylvia Tyus  
at the time of the sealing & delivery of this present may be possessed of
