This Indenture made the ninth day of July one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight
 in the eighth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord King George the third Between
 Sharp of Southampton county Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Turner of
 county of colony of said of the other part witnesseth that the said Governor Sharp for
 in consideration of the sum of forty nine pounds current money of Virginia to him in
 hand paid by the said Benjamin Turner at & before the making & delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Governor Sharp
 hereof acquit & discharge the said Benjamin Turner his heirs executors administrators
 and assigns for ever by their presents hath granted bargain sold aliened released and
 confirmed of by their presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm
 unto the said Benjamin Turner his heirs and assigns for ever the following
 parcel of land containing one hundred & fifty acres better or less
 lying & being in Southampton county being part of tract of land containing three
 hundred & fifty acres formerly belonging to Francis Sharp lying on the south side
 of the swamp (and bounded as followeth) to wit: beginning at a Hickory tree
 between the said Sharp & Mrs. Garrison & thence towards the same
