

of the Swamp to a large ash & small, on the north side of the said swamp they being the
 trees marked in the presence of each of the aforesaid Kennetwicks & Mr. Kirby. In the above said
 Joshua Nicholson then near or quite a south corner by a line of marked trees which was marked
 in presence of the aforesaid persons, that divided the said land from the said ^{William} Kennetwicks
 land to a black gum on the south side of the Pasture branch. then up the various corners
 of the said Pasture branch to a pine near the head of the said Pasture branch then over
 a ridge by a line of marked trees made in presence of the aforesaid persons to a large
 pine on the south side of the Pasture branch a corner tree of the land that was formerly the
 father then down the various corners of the said Pasture branch to a pine corner tree of
 William Kirby. then along the said Kirby line of marked trees to the said Pasture
 branch to two Spanish oaks then down the said Pasture branch to Coker Swamp then
 up the said swamp to the mouth of the long branch to an ash corner tree of the
 land on the north side of the said Coker Swamp then along a line of marked trees to
 a Buckhorn then along a Buckhorn to a Red Pittie then down the said Pittie
 to the beginning containing as is returned by the said Kennetwicks & Mr. Kirby
 according to the same more or less part of the land was granted by patent (to Nicholas Coker)
 bearing date the thirteenth day of Oct. 1727 for 90 Acres part of another patent granted for
 105 Acres to Henry Vaughan bearing date the 10 day of July 1755 part of another patent
 granted to the said Vaughan for 136 Acres bearing date August 16 1756 and part of
 another patent granted to the said Mr. Kennetwicks for 21 Acres bearing date the 10
 day of Sept. 1760 - To have & to hold the said land estimated at two hundred & fifty
 acres with all & every the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Jacob
 Kennetwicks to his heirs & assigns forever To the only persons and behoof of the said
 Jacob Kennetwicks his heirs and assigns forever of the said William Kennetwicks
 both for himself & his heirs & assigns forever & agree with the said Jacob Kennetwicks
 his heirs and assigns that the said Mr. Kennetwicks his heirs & assigns
 will now & at all times hereafter for ever warrant & defend the above mentioned
 land estimated at two hundred & fifty acres with the appurtenances thereto be-
 longing unto the aforesaid Jacob Kennetwicks his heirs & assigns against the
 claim & title of all & every person & persons whatsoever In witness whereof the
