

This Indenture made the eighteenth day of Jan^y, in the eighth
 Day of our sovereign Lord George the third King of Great Britain Trans-
 Tyler sold Christ on the one hand seven hundred & fifty eight between Daniel Doyle
 his wife of the parish of Tottenham County of Southhampton of the one part
 Tyler of the parish of St. Mary of the other part witnesseth that the said
 his wife for consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds money
 to be paid unto her by the said Daniel Doyle & Mary his wife
 the receipt whereof the said Daniel & Mary his wife do hereby acknowledge
 the receipt of the said Daniel & Mary his wife do hereby acknowledge
 by these presents the said Daniel Doyle & Mary his wife have granted
 bargain'd sold alien'd enfeoff'd confirmed & by these presents do grant bargain
 sell alien'd enfeoff'd confirmed unto the said Edward Tyler & his heirs & assigns forever
 all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the parish of St. Mary
 bounded as followeth to wit: Beginning at a corner of the said
 Thornby his lands to a red oak corner of the said Edm^d Tyler & Chas^r Corby then by
 Corby line to Sarat's Branch & up the said branch a strong tree of division
 this land from the land of the late Edm^d Doyle & up the said strong
 white oak corner of J^r Benoit thence along his line to a corner tree
 James line thence along his line to a brick corner of Edm^d Tyler & up
 line to the beginning containing by estimation two hundred & fifty acres better
 James more or less which said tract or parcel of land was purchased by the said
 Daniel Doyle at public auction of the goods of Edward Doyle late of the county
 of Kent & by them conveyed by indenture of record bearing date the eighteenth day
 of Jan^y 1768 records in the court of the county of Southhampton above said relation
 being it unto be had may more fully appear & all houses out houses & curtilages
 yards gardens orchards trees ways waters watercourses profits commodities
 hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation tract or parcel
 of land belonging or any way appertaining & the revenues & reversions &
 and remainders with issue profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof
 & all the estate right title interest possession property claim & demand whatsoever
 of them the said Daniel Doyle & Mary his wife of in or to the same
 part or parcel thereof & all deeds evidence & writings or any wise concerning the
 same To have & to hold the said plantation tract or parcel of land & premises
 with the appurtenances unto the said Edm^d Tyler his heirs & assigns to the only
 persons & behoof of him the said Edm^d Tyler his heirs & assigns forever
 & the said Daniel Doyle for himself his heirs executor & administrators
