

This Indenture

made the sixth day of October the Year of our Lord

Anno domini 1668 between Thomas Barnes of the County of Southampton

County of the other hand witnesseth that the said Thomas Barnes for his own

in hand paid by Benjamin Whitfield the receipt whereof the said Thomas Barnes

both hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened in fee and

confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien in fee

and confirm unto the said Benjamin Whitfield his heirs and assigns for

ever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of

Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and seventy acres

be the same more or less Beginning at a gum tree north 70 degrees

east 132 poles to a black oak thence south thirty degrees east 100 poles to a

live oak by the side of the Cypress

Swamp pond on the northeast side thereof and up the various courses

the run of the said swamp to the beginning. With all trees woods underwoods

common ground pasture profit commodities advantages emblements

hereditaments whatsoever to the plantation or tract of land belonging or in any

wise appertaining or upon the same growing happening or arising and also

the reversion and reversions remainers and remainders with services of the

premises and every part thereof gave all the estate right title interest

claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Thomas Barnes of in or to the same

premises and every part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the

said premises abovementioned and every part & parcel thereof with the ap-

purtenances unto the said Benjamin Whitfield his heirs and assigns

to the only proper use and behoof of the said Benjamin Whitfield his

heirs and assigns for ever and the said Thomas Barnes for himself

and his heirs the said plantation and premises and every part thereof

against him and his heirs and against all and every other person or

persons whatsoever unto the said Benjamin Whitfield his heirs and

assigns shall defend warrant and for ever defend by these presents
