 on thousand seven hundred and sixty eight Between John Carr of North Carolina of the one part
 his wife of the county of Bath of province of North Carolina of the one part
 and John Oley of the county of Isle of Wight and colony of Virginia of the other part
 witnesseth that the said John Carr for and in consideration
 of the sum of fifty pounds current money of Virginia to in hand paid by the
 said John Oley jun^r. the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge of themselves
 fully satisfied contented and paid and doth acquit and discharge
 the said John Oley jun^r. and hath hereby granted bargained sold aliened
 enfeoffed and confirmed unto the said John Oley his heirs executors admors
 assigns two certain tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the county
 of Southampton one tract being 150 acres the plantation whereon Rob^t.
 Carr formerly lives adjoining the lands of W^madhu Smith Giles John
 Thomas Jones ver^r and W^mosey Johnson also 25 acres being part of a tract
 Rob^t. Carr purchased of John Barnes adjoining Simon Johnson land
 Rob^t. Carr jun^r. Now this Indenture witnesseth that
 whereas Rob^t. Carr the elder by his last will and testament bearing
 date the 9 day of June 1763 devised the above tract of land to his son
 John Carr his youngest son Now the said John Carr for the
 above mentioned sum of fifty pounds have sold and conveyed the
 said lands and premises unto the said John Oley his heirs executors
 assigns forever the reversion & reversions remainder & remainder
 To have and to hold the said tract or parcels of land with all the
