 the receipt whereof the said Edm. Tyler & Sarah his wife doth hereby acknowledge
 that they acquit and discharge the said Wm Jones his heirs executors and administrators by their
 presents that the said Edm. Tyler & Sarah his wife have granted bargained sold
 aliened conveyed confirmed given by their presents as grand bargain sell alien
 conveyed and confirmed unto the said Wm Jones his heirs and assigns for ever
