This Indenture made this tenth day of Nov^r one thousand seven hundred &
 sixty eight Between Henry Taylor of the parish of St Luke & County of Southampton
 Gent. of the one part and Hartwell Howell of the parish of St Nicholas County of
 Breconshire Gent. of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Taylor for & in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds current money of Virginia to him in
 hand paid by the said Hartwell Howell at or before the enrolling & delivering
 of these presents the receipt whereof the said Henry Taylor doth hereby acknowledging
 of thereof acquit & discharge the said Hartwell Howell his heirs & assigns forever
 for ever by these presents the said Henry Taylor hath granted bargained sold
 aliened released & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
 release confirm unto the said Hartwell Howell his heirs & assigns forever
 All that the said Henry Taylor his plantation tract or parcel of land situated
 lying & being on the south side of Norway river in the parish of St Luke County
 of Southampton containing two hundred & eighty seven acres formerly belonging
 to the Norway Indians & by their chiefs in conjunction with their trustees
 conveyed to the said Henry Taylor by a deed bearing date the twelfth day of Nov^r
 one thousand seven hundred & sixty two the said land being distinguished in the
 survey or plat by the N^o 1 & according to the said plat bounded as followeth
 to wit beginning at a small pine a corner of N^o 1 bar Bushhorn road then
 up the various courses of the said road to a black oak a corner of N^o 2
 thence S. W. two hundred & fifty five to a small black oak thence S. E. bearing
