Gurly his heirs & assigns absolutely fully & freely give grant bargain sell
confer confirm unto the said George Gurly his heirs and assigns forever
their heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation three hundred
acres more or less lying & being in the County of Southampton
on the north side of Meherrin river & bounded as followeth. Beginning
from the side of the Cabin Swamp thence north sixty degrees over twelve
pole to a pine along Edwards Chittys land thence north 30. over twenty two
pole to a white oak thence south sixty five degrees east thirty three pole to a
lightwood post in Samuel Bridges line thence south seventy five degrees west
eighty pole to a white oak thence north twenty five degrees west seventy pole to a
red oak thence north twenty five degrees east seventy two pole to a pine thence
south seventy five degrees east two hundred & thirty pole to a live oak in the
Wolf Run branch thence south sixty five degrees east one hundred & ten pole to a
thence south forty degrees east one hundred & eight pole to a pine thence south
sixty four pole to a white oak in the county line thence by said line over sixty
one pole to a gum thence north twenty five degrees over twelve pole to the

to be granted premises & every part & parcel thereof all & singular the rents

his heirs executors and administrators doth covenant grant & agree to & with the
said George Gurly his heirs in manner & form following (that is to say) that the
