This Indenture made this day of December in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred & eighty eight between Henry Crafford of Southampton
 county of the one part & John Crafford of the same county of the other part witness
 that the said Henry Crafford for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings
 current money of Virginia to him in hand paid before the sealing & delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof the said Henry Crafford doth acknowledge
 hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed unto the said John
 Crafford & to his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of land whereon
 he now lives lying & being in the said county of Southampton on the south
 side of McWhorter river containing one hundred & fifty more or less beginning
 at a Hickory on the bank of McWhorter river Cap. Peterson corner tree then
 along Peterson line to the back line then up the back line to the country
 line & up the country line to McWhorter river aforesaid then down the river
 to the beginning To have and to hold the aforesaid one hundred & fifty
 more of land with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens woods
 trees ways water water courses profit commodities hereditaments
