 acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened in fee simple & confirmed by their
 present doth grant bargain & sell alien in fee simple & confirmed to the said Conjer
 Morris his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing
 two hundred and seventy acres more or less situate lying & being in the county of
 Southampton bounded as followeth Viz beginning a firm in Edward Harris
 line in the middle of the said survey so running a north westerly course by a
 line of marked trees down to Warwick branch to a white oak on the other side
 the said survey so keeping the course of the said Patent to include all the land
 and of the said survey and also all trees woods underwoods commons
