This Indenture made this fourteenth day of Jan^y in the ninth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord George the third now being of Great Britain &c. in the year of our Lord Christ 1769 Between Will^m Jones of the parish of Wotton in the county of Southampton of the one part & Thomas Budd of the same county of the other part witnesseth that the said Will^m Jones for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds current money of Virginia in hand paid by the said ^{the Budd} at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Will^m Jones hath thereof acquit & discharged the said Thomas Budd, hath granted bargained & sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien & confirm unto the said Thos. Budd his heirs & assigns for ever all that certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the parish and county aforesaid containing by estimation three hundred & some acres of land be the same more or less & bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a live oak on the east side of the Appamunac swamp thence east 102 poles to a red oak thence north 120 to three trees chopit inward thence west 484 poles to a cypress by the side of the Appamunac swamp thence down the various courses of the run of the said Swamp to the beginning It being the land that Jas. Harris bought of the chief men of the Mattoway Indians as by a deed bearing date the 7 day of August 1735 & since conveyed by James Harris & Cherry Roykin to Benjamin Arrington as by a deed bearing date the 12 day of May 1763 & since conveyed by the said Benjamin Arrington to the said William Jones as by a deed bearing date the twenty ninth day of June 1763 & all houses & out houses & woods & underwoods & gardens & orchards & trees & ways & water & water courses & profits
