 proved by the oaths of Henry Crafford Ephraim Peckles & Hardy Deal
 the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded test Peckles

This Indenture made this 13th day of April in the ninth year of the
 reign of our sovereign Lord George the third now King of Great Britain &c
 And in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
 sixty nine Between Robert Newson of the Parish of Saint Lukes in the
 County of Southampton of the one Part and William Newson and
 Thomas Newson of the same Parish and County of the other Part
 Witnesses that the said Robert Newson for and in consideration
 of the sum of sixty six Pounds twelve Shillings and eight Pence
 current money of Virginia to him in hand Paid by the said William Newson
 and Thomas Newson the Receipt whereof the said Robert Newson doth
 hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said William
 Newson and Thomas Newson their heirs executors and Administrators by
 these Presents but the said Robert Newson hath granted Bargained &
 sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these Presents doth grant bargain
 and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said William Newson
 and Thomas Newson and to their heirs and assigns forever all that
 tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid Parish
 and County on the south side of notaway river containing by estimation
 three hundred and seventy five acres be the same more or less and bounded
 as followeth to wit Beginning at the great branch by Henry Thomases line
 up the said branch to William Thomases line ^{along the said line} to a corner Tree a Spanish
 oak from thence along a line of faye Vassons ^{land} to a corner tree of Joseph
 Newsons land from thence a straight line to Tucknathuntas swamp
 and down the said swamp to the beginning also the goods & chattels
 (to wit) one house sixteen battle six sheep sixty four hogs
